Buses

Space on the buses is limited. You are advised to book early in order to ensure a place. The buses are for children living at a distance from Farington Hall, and older children living close to the site should walk wherever possible. Once all the places are filled parents will need to make alternative travel arrangements.

Suggestions on ensuring your child's well being on the buses are made on the information sheet you will receive upon enrolling.

All buses return in reverse order and will endeavour to keep to the times indicated in the information you receive. However delays are always possible so please bear with us should any such delay occur.

Anyone making their own travel arrangements should arrive at the site between 8:30 - 9:30 and depart again between 3:30 - 4:00.

Grouping

Where possible we will try to comply with requests to ensure children that want to be together are placed into the same group. If you want your child to be with friends then please think of a group name and write it in the box provided. (E.g. *Town Lane Group*) All registrations received with the same group name will be placed together.

5pm Club

The 5pm Club is in place for parents who want to collect their children from site after the usual time of 3:30pm. For an extra £30 children will be offered entertainment and activities and a snack up until 5:30pm.

Processing Time

Registrations will be processed 2 weeks prior to the Playscheme and your *registration cards will be sent out at this time along with your bus times.*

This will allow us to tailor the buses to expected numbers and provide an even more efficient service.

Any changes to groupings after this date will incur an administration charge of £5 per move.
