Mega week is back! Welcome to the 2011 Samlesbury Playscheme. We look forward to registering your children again for yet another fun packed week of sports, games and the kind of days out that all children love to take part in.

Every child aged 5 – 14 years is welcome to take part in the Scheme and is registered into a group and section of their own age group.

Groups consist of : Infants 5 – 7 years --- Mainstream 8 – 11 years and Teenz 12 – 14 years

Activities on and off site are tailored to suit each age group accordingly.

Following the success of previous years, deregistration will again be at 3.30pm, which means that buses will depart around 4pm. Parents bringing children by car should arrive for registration at 9.30am and at the end of the day should collect from the Canberra Club main entrance at 4pm except BAE employees who may arrive from 8am and collect no later than 5pm.

Use the Scheme, remember we are happy to register friends and family into the same groups wherever possible but to assist with this please try to register these children at the same time or make a note on their Enrolment Form to tell us who they would like to be with.

INFANTS SECTION – Age 5 – 7 years

For activities in this age group we are again likely to include: Swimming - probably at Pontins Southport, Adventure Soft Play at Puddletown Pirates and a visit to an Animal Farm or Wildlife Centre.

Usually on site activities will include Sports, Games, Arts & Crafts along with visits by a mobile Mini Zoo and other Entertainers.

Note seat-belted buses will be used for all dedicated Infant trips off site.

MAINSTREAM SECTION – Age 8 – 11 years

For this age group activities are again likely to include: Swimming, Ice Skating, 10 Pin Bowling, Cinema and others.

On site activities involving various Sports, Games, Craft sessions, music and entertainment are planned.

Remember that some of the venues have specific requirements ie Ice Skaters must wear socks. Parents will be advised which day each group will be going swimming.

'XTREME TEENZ' – Age 12 – 14 years

As in previous years this age group will again be split into various activity groups which children can choose at the time of registration.

Larger groups have been created to reflect the most popular activities but as always places will be limited due to restrictions on numbers allocated by the various venues used.

Last year, as in other years, these groups filled very quickly so don't delay—register now!!!

- A. JUST 4 FUN** – this is a mixture of various FUN activities which are on offer plus a chance to take part in some of the other activities, depending upon availability.
- B. OUTDOOR ADVENTURE** – the most popular of all packages it comprises of outdoor activities run at a registered activity centre with qualified and experienced staff.
- C. HEALTH & BEAUTY** – a selection of Health & Beauty treatments will be on offer in this section. Section activities will be for half a day with fun activities filling the rest of the day.
- D. WORLD OF SPORT** – this group will take part in a variety of sports including: Football, Snooker, Golf plus others and will include visits to sporting places of interest.
- E. GLEE CLUB** – new this year, this group with focus both on stage crafts and technical skills involved in putting on a show.

When not taking part in their group activities the 'Teenz' will choose from Swimming, Ice Skating, 10 Pin Bowling, Cinema and get involved in other on site activities.
